- 3. Send a list of books read, including title, author and number of pages.
- 4. Total the number of books and the number of pages read.
- 5. Each entry must include the following: Name, Grange including number, Address, Total number of books read, and Total number of pages read. Juniors should include their age as of September 1. A list of the books read should also be included in the entry. A template that may be used to record books read is included in this booklet.

Awards

Deadline: <u>One hour</u> after the opening on the first day of the 2024 State Grange session.

- 1. Open to all Subordinate Grange Members.
- 2. Entries must have been colored during the contest year (10/1/24-10/1/25).
- 3. All entriesmust be from an adult coloring book.
- 4. All entries must be Grange appropriate.
- 5. Members may enter as many pieces as they wish.
- 6. Entry, including matting/backing, must be no smaller than 4" x 6" and not larger than 11" x 14".
- 7. Frames and glass are **NOT** permitted.
- 8. Labels (included in this booklet) must be affixed to the lower righthand corner of the photo.

- 2. Age groups for Junior's entries are 5 -7; 8 10; and 11 - 14. (as of 10/1/25)
- 3. Entries must have been produced during the contest year (10/1/24 10/1/25).
- 4. Artist must select the category for his/ her entry.
- 5. Members may enter as many pieces of artwork in a single category as they wish.
- 6. Entries must have a frame with suitable hangers or hard matting/backing suitable so they may be displayed.
- 7. Glass is **NOT** permitted, however Plexiglas is allowed.
- 8. Labels (included in this booklet) must be affixed to the lower right hand corner of the artwork.
