Our sales table at the annual state session in 2023 was busy but not as successful as in past years. We had a great raffle and many Grange sale items available. In all, we cleared \$325.00.

As spring arrived, we started discussing plans for the annual State Grange Yard Sale. Due to several reasons, it was decided to forgo making and selling "take-out" meals this year. Instead, we chose to have a raffle for 2 \$100 VISA gift cards and a sales table. We sent raffle tickets in advance to Granges, Pomonas, State Officers and Committee members and asked that they sell them. A big Thank-you to those Granges or individuals who sold tickets or bought tickets. Your help is always appreciated. We also made the decision to let Manchester Grange oversee renting the table spaces for the sale and let them keep the profit as they very generously let us use the hall each year for this event free of charge.
